TRAINING OR RESEARCH ACTIVITY

My doctoral thesis focuses on legitimacy in the context of ethnic conflicts and international administrations. My current research, which follows the doctoral thesis, examines three different sectors in post-Brussels Kosovo (paper to be submitted in October 2020). The first sector is the rule of law, which is the pivotal element of the Agreement and requires three-level authority (at least in its initial stage). The second is the energy sector that is another element of the Agreement; which is based on two-level authority - local and parallel. And finally, the third sector is education, omitted in the Agreement and as such rests simultaneously on parallel (North Kosovo and enclaves) and local (the rest of the polity) authorities. It seems that a formal agreement between the opposing sides neither paves the way to the final solution nor improves the everyday lives of ordinary people if not meticulously planned and supervised by an international authority. The case of Kosovo shows that freshly formed democratic institutions cannot be left without international supervision even after a formal agreement. In addition to my research on the Balkan region, I am interested in neighbouring fields such as European solidarity and politics and culture of Central Europe. Following that desire, I am also currently working on the topic "Christian ethics as an element of European solidarity" (literature review stage).
