## TRAINING OR RESEARCH ACTIVITY

Currently, my research agenda focuses on social stratification, intergenerational social mobility studies, by applying new and non-standard approaches to social mobility; educational inequalities in both vertical and horizontal dimensions (e.g. also by employing factor analysis); over birth cohorts, also in a comparative perspective.

I am interested in gender differences, for example in labour market segregation by employing a micro-class approach, gender pay gap, in a comparative perspective.

My research interests, my statistical teaching experience, my conferences and workshops participations and organizations, make me believe that the natural next step will be focusing my teaching agenda on quantitative methods to social sciences – by employing a wide range of statistical techniques, on both cross-sectional, cross-national dataset, and large-scale longitudinal data (e.g. administrative data).

My strong knowledge in sociological theories, allows me to teach how to conduct research from the theoretical framework, concepts operationalisations, data analysis, and the related results discussions.



I combined my experience in social stratification and new frontiers in educational and social mobility studies, (such using newer techniques and/or different conceptualizations and a re-operationalization of these concepts), also thanks to my contacts with research in various European countries (e.g. all the Nordic countries which relates to two projects mentioned above; France, Germany, Italy, etc.).

This allows expending my career goals, from publishing in competitive academic journals, to preparing competitive project proposals at national and European level, in line with a quantitative sociology professor profile.

In addition, my intent to get research funding at national and European/international levels, first, could be a crucial asset for your institutions, and second to students, which could participate to different stage of research projects. This is, in my opinion, a very useful way to teach them what means making research in practical terms.

I am also teaching in workshop (e.g at the University of Trento, University of Turku) how to write project for different funding (e.g. private Foundation, or government funding – cf. Jan Peter Erola).

I have also been a lecturer in quantitative methods for social sciences since my Ph.D. studies in Trento School of Social Sciences onwards. Within this School, I supervised a PhD student for two before my car accident and related sickness leave. Moreover, I am experience in teaching longitudinal and multilevel methods in social sciences (as reported into details in my CV).

I am a proficient user of Stata as well as social mobility modelling and analysis in R, or LEM, Lisrel, SPSS.
