Consequences of Immigration into the United States - focus on Older Natives and Highly Educated Natives

• Estimated the impact of immigration in the labor force participation decisions of older U.S. workers eligible for reduced Social Security benefits at the Early Eligibility Age (EEA), to possibly address the long run insolvency of the U.S. Social Security system



• Studied task specialization decision (by performing more managerial activities) of U.S.-born natives within their occupation, i.e., without needing to change or shift occupations, in response to immigrant inflows

• Empirical methods: Reduced form regressions, 2-stage least squares (Bartik-style instrumental variables), Least squares, Fixed effects

Determinants of Immigration into the United States - Disease Outbreaks and International Student Enrollment

• Used the exogenous shock of past disease outbreaks in foreign countries to examine the impacts on international student enrollment in the U.S. from affected countries; compiled panel dataset of 129 countries for 18 academic years by country-year and international student enrollment in the U.S.

• Empirical methods: Difference-in-differences
