## TRAINING OR RESEARCH ACTIVITY

In my research, I focus on the furthering of the European integration by establishing a genuine European Fiscal Union. One of my research objectives is to investigate whether the current EU fiscal framework has benevolent effects on the public finances of the member states (MS). In such a context, I examine the quality of the fiscal rules at the EU and the MS level, and carefully accommodate the evolution of fiscal indicators. For this purpose, I rely on the regression analysis by setting up dynamic panels using the EViews interface. On the qualitative side, I employ the qualitative content analysis (QCA) of policy proposals, legal documents and relevant scholarship so as to identify different trends in the EU fiscal policy-making. This process has been aided by borrowing from theories on fiscal federalism, European integration and differentiated integration.
