The work assesses how EU economic governance contributes to the composition of national public expenditures across the 28 Member States since the introduction of the EMU. It maps the configurations of EU and national level factors under which the supranational fiscal rule does and does not impact the domestic fiscal policy mix. The analysis considers dynamics during and after the Great Recession, their distributive consequences, core-periphery divergences, together with their broader political, economic and social implications.</p>
