I am a fourth-year PhD student at the department of economics of the EUI in Florence, under the supervision of Andrea Mattozzi and David Levine. My areas of expertise are political economy, development economics, and economic history. My research agenda deals with the analysis of the mutual relations of political institutions and markets, and specifically with questions related to the role of the former in the origin of growth in capitalist societies.

2021-current	<ul style="list-style-type: none">“The long-term effect of colonial state capacity: Evidence from India”, started in 2021, and in the process of revise and resubmit at the Journal of Development Economics. <p>In Central India, the river Narmada separates two regions that have experimented a different type of government only during the colonial period, for reasons orthogonal to their economic development. I implement a spatial RDD on the population in the early Nineteenth Century, as well as on proxies of health and wealth in 2015. The findings show that enhancing state capacity has a long-term effect, and I discuss the following transmission mechanism. The southern region, which had become part of a state with more modern fiscal capacity, benefitted from the first trans-continental railway, as it led to openness to trade with the rest of the world. Although the colonial administration directed public investment to meet British (not local) economic goals, my work provides an explanation as to how the growth in efficacy and structure of an embryonal state can sustain that of the markets it deems relevant.</p>
2022-current	<ul style="list-style-type: none">“Targeted spending: The effect of elections on the distribution of discretionary jobs within the Italian bureaucracy”, started in 2022. <p>The research question of this paper is whether leaving too much discretion to political decision-making can result in a strategic usage of public revenues. To this end, I exploit the fact that, under certain conditions, Italian regional councils can appoint employees bypassing the standard procedure, which requires public competition. Using the 2020</p>



pandemic shock, which caused the deferral of seven regional elections, I estimate a DID model with wild bootstrapping. My results show a sharp negative effect on the percentage of employees hired by the regions where they were born, if these regions have had their elections postponed, as opposed to the regions that were not supposed to hold elections in the same period. This result highlights that incumbents can tailor discretionary public expenditures towards voters that are ex-ante more likely to be pivotal, as only residents can vote in regional elections. Indeed, the effect shows up right after it became clear that elections were not as near as it had been originally planned, and only in the quarter following the deferral.
