My Phd thesis entitled 'Rivers and Humans as Holders of the Right to Water: Between Realization and Reconciliation' tackles with many themes covered by the research project. In particular, since the right to water has been derived from the right to environment on many occasions, it studies the components of the procedural right to environment, namely the rights to obtain environmental information and participate in environmental decision-making, in detail by comparing the provisions of the Escazu Agreement and Aarhus Convention. Similarly, it studies the recognition of rights of nature in various jurisdictions comparatively as an unorthodox and revolutionary tool within the framework of participatory rights.
