As a Visiting Professor and Visiting Scholar at the Pettit College of Law, Center for Democratic Governance and Rule of Law, Ohio Northern University, Ada, OH, USA I did a comparative research study on corruption as a wider economic and socio-political phenomenon that is spread around the human globe, both relevant to the field of law and comparative politics and public policy, but also suitable for a wide range of both graduate and undergraduate students in political science, public policy, international affairs, business (international business ethics), and law (white-collar crimes)—a multidisciplinary approach. Research emphasized the effects of corruption as a complex social, political, and economic phenomenon, undermining democratic institutions, perverting the rule of law, and creating bureaucratic quagmires whose only reason for existing is the soliciting of bribes, slowing economic development, and contributing to government instability.
