Behavioral Economics in Sports:

During the Ph.D. research I extended Behavioral Economics to sports contexts, analyzing how cognitive biases impact athletes’ performance and referees’ decision-making. This research unveiled crucial insights into psychological factors affecting sports strategies and athlete behavior. This involved advanced data collection techniques utilizing Python and R for web scraping, ensuring a comprehensive and nuanced data analysis.

Complementing my research, I served as a tutor in a Machine Learning Master’s program, where I could deepen data analysis and machine learning applications in economics. This role also enhanced my expertise in data-driven research methodologies.
