GRUPPO DI QUESITI N. 1

Student fairs

The University runs information stands at many of the numerous events taking place all over Italy, aimed at providing advice and guidance on studying at University to secondary school students.

These student fairs provide a unique and special opportunity for schools and universities, and increasingly often, for universities and the world of work, to come into contact, and often take place in exhibition spaces equipped with the appropriate facilities for hosting not only the stands run by the large numbers of representatives from the higher education sector, but also all the meetings, seminars, debates, workshops and conferences that help to enrich the visitors' experience and promote the exchange of information and expertise between operators in the sector.

From Verona to Bari, from Varese to Palermo, the orientation tours run by the University of Milan in the last few years have covered numerous big and small cities in Italy.

GRUPPO DI QUESITI N. 2

Admission to programmes

Open-admission programmes, in which there is no cap on student numbers. Each degree programme defines the basic knowledge and requirements for matriculation; these may be verified through a compulsory, non-selective test for assessing the student's educational background, or through an interview prior to matriculation. If the evaluation test reveals a learning gap, the applicant can still enrol as long as he/she has sat the exam.



Capped-enrolment programmes, in which only a limited number of places are available, as determined by the University or by the Italian Ministry for Universities and Research (MUR). To enrol, students must register for an entrance examination, pass it and rank high enough to be awarded one of the places available. Some programmes base the rankings on applicants' secondary school-leaving mark (voto di maturità).

Presentation of Master's degree programmes

Master's degree programmes are not usually presented in a single orientation event. Annual presentation meetings by disciplinary area or degree programme are organized according to the specific communication agenda of each area from March to June.

International enrolment in degree programmes

University enrolment in Italy is regulated by ministerial provisions that establish different admission procedures for EU or EU-equivalent students and non-EU students residing abroad.

Italian, European or non-European citizens with residence permits shall apply directly to the University. They need not pass any Italian proficiency test and are admitted with no quotas.

On the contrary, non-EU students residing abroad are required to submit a pre-enrolment application on University website. University acceptance does not confer any right to the completion of the enrolment process, even in the cases of:

- study visa obtainment;
- physical presence in the country;
- eligibility and/or obtainment of scholarships or grants of all kinds;
- conditional acceptance in order to start didactic activities.
