OTHER INFORMATION

My master thesis studied the Cooperation and Facilitation Investment Agreements adopted by Brazil, a new generation investment treaty that includes provisions concerning corporate social responsibility as well as environment, labor affairs, health and corruption and exemplifies a significant embodiment of the ESG principles in private international law. My PhD thesis entitled 'Rivers and Humans as Holders of the Right to Water: Between Realization and Reconciliation' tackles with the issues falling within the scope of the research project 'The Enforcement of ESG Principles in a Transnational Dimension: a EU and Private International Law Perspective.' Indeed, the second chapter focusing on the traditional legal frameworks that emerged to tackle with the global water crisis presents the controversial nature of the status of corporations as duty bearers under international human rights law and studies the international soft law instruments as well as national and regional laws that target corporations' conduct that fall short of human rights standards. In doing so, it emphasizes the manner in which the latter laws have extraterritorial effect. In addition, the fifth chapter focusing on the enforcement of the traditional legal frameworks studies, among others, foreign direct liability cases and lays down the barriers to the obtaining of justice by those that pursue them. In addition, it studies the enforcement of the rights to water and sanitation before the World Bank Inspection Panel, ISDS tribunals, OECD national contact points as well as the content of the Hague Rules on Business and Human Rights Arbitration.
