Degree of medical specialization	Summary: This thesis focuses on the characteristics of a specific mantra called subrhmaṇyā which is recited by the subrahmaṇya priests to call Indra to the soma sacrifice. This is described in Vedic literature, particularly in the Sāmaveda literature: Pañcaviṃśa-Brāhmaṇa, Şaḍviṃśa-Brāhmaṇa, Lāṭyāyaṇa-Śrautasūtra, Drāhyāyana-Śrautasūtra and Jaiminīya-Śrautasūtra.
