Classes on machine-learning including statistics and text analysis as part of PhD program building compentency in these methods and utilizing both R and Python intensively.

Thesis research on Collective Victimhood in US politics by political elites and on cable news. This involved scraping large quantities of text data and applying a range of NLP techniques including supervised and unsupervised machine-learning approaches as well as integrating the use of Large Language Models into the training of classifiers. Substantively these narratives often intersect with gender and class, whether they be narratives of exploitation by powerful groups or 'backlash' against marginalized groups or those advocating on behalf of the marginalized.

2024	A Public Value Accounting System for Forensic Services - Acting as a consultant for statistical analysis of how the Police Service of Northern Ireland make use of forensic evidence in collaboration with academics at Ulster University. We make use of a range of traditional statistical methods along with machine-learning to cluster and detect patterns in the data to produce a report on cost effectiveness in Northern Irish policing.
2020-2024	'Extreme Identities' - NORFACE funded project analyzing the far-right online eco-system in collaboration with Exeter, Copenhagen and Trinity College. We scraped social media and websites belonging to the far-right for a large data approach to analyzing extremist text and images.
