



International 4EU+ Semester in Geography

Call for applications for a short-term stay abroad in the Fall Semester 2024/25

The 4EU+ Alliance is breaking new ground for a joint teaching offer of the participating universities. In this context, plug-in modules were developed for the **study of geography** at the partner universities.

For the selected students, there is the possibility for a stay of at least two months (October-December) at one of the universities listed below. During this time, two or three modules with a total of up to 30 ECTS can be completed. Funding is provided by an Erasmus scholarship (€ 300/month for Germany and France; € 250/month for Poland).

Who can apply

Application requirements are listed below:

1. Being regularly enrolled at the University of Milan for the 2023/2024 academic year, on the *Analisi, pianificazione e gestione sostenibile del territorio* or *Environmental Change and Global Sustainability* or *Environmental and food economics*;
2. Being current with tuition and fee payments;
3. Not being a recipient of any other EU grant for stays abroad that overlap, even partially, with the 4EU+ Semester period.

All students must be enrolled in a study programme of the University for the academic year 2024/2025 upon departure, and maintain this status during their period abroad.

Study Content

At each university, two (three at the Sorbonne Université) 4EU+ Modules are available, resulting in a total of up to 30 ECTS. These modules are recognised as credit by the University of Milan (Annex 1).

Application: Please apply by **12/06/2024** by email to 4euplusmobility@unimi.it (with subject line: 4EU+ Semester) including the following documentation:

- 1) A motivation letter (PDF/A file) including the chosen destination;
- 2) Signed CV and copy of ID (PDF file);
- 3) Self-certified transcript of records (to be printed from Unimia as a PDF file);
- 4) An official language certification recognized by the University ([list](#)) or a language proficiency statement obtained through the University Language Centre – SLAM. Students who are enrolled in degree programmes entirely taught in English are considered to automatically meet their English language requirement up to the level required for admission to their degree programme.

Selection process

A Rector-appointed board will select up to 4 students on the following criteria:

- a) Academic career (up to 10 points);
- b) Language skills (up to 8 points);
- c) Candidate's motivation (up to 12 points).

Exchanges shall be conditional upon the partner's approval and nomination's acceptance.

Extensions are not granted automatically and must always be authorised by both your UNIMI coordinator and the responsible person abroad.
