ATTIVITÀ DI FORMAZIONE O DI RICERCA

descrizione dell'attività My PhD research project focuses on sustainable welfare and a degrowth transition. More specifically, my research focuses on unconditional basic income (UBI) as an eco-social policy for a degrowth transition. Despite UBI's prevalence within the degrowth literature, there is currently a lack of empirical focus on the policy's ecological credentials and few detailed proposals for UBI which is compatible with degrowth perspectives. My research, therefore, is attempting to begin addressing this gap. I am completing my PhD by publication, meaning I am writing a series of academic papers which will be included in the overall thesis. The first paper (published in <i>Futures</i>) highlights the disconnect between visions for UBI in the degrowth literature and the focus of extant empirical research, which aligns more strongly with extant growth objectives, and presents an alternative research agenda for a degrowth compatible UBI. My additional publications attempt to begin to action this agenda. They include an examination of UBI and sustainable wellbeing, using Max-Neef's framework of fundamental human needs; a proposal for a laboratory experiment investigating changes to consumption behaviours under UBI conditions; and a critical systematic literature review of funding options for sustainable welfare.

It was one of the first pilots to employ a 'community saturation' approach, allowing an examination of the collective impacts of UBI. As part of the research team, I fed into the research design, conducted qualitative interviews and focus groups with participants; and am also involved in the data analysis.
2023-2024	HudsonUP UBI Pilot - member of the analysis team for the HudsonUP pilot experiment, USA. Involved analysing interview transcripts according to Max-Neef's HSD framework, culminating in the writing of an upcoming paper.
