## **Call for applications for students enrolled at the University of Milan in the BA Studies in Cultural Heritage**

*Visual Literacy. Understanding images across Europe – Past and present*, one-year international seminar programme, aims to experience first-hand the cultural framework of the ways in which images were and are perceived in different places and contexts, through work on scientific-artistic projects carried out in intercultural groups. The educational project includes online conversatory classes, tutorials group projects, and three two-days workshops in Milan, Prague, and Warsaw, from November 2024 to June 2025.

The course is jointly offered by University of Warsaw, Charles University (Prague), University of Milan.

The selected students of the University of Milan (BA Studies in Cultural Heritage) will participate in the following mobility experiences: Prague (March 20-21, 2025), Warsaw (June 5-6, 2025) and will received a mobility grant, as detailed below.

The mobility grant is provided as a lump sum according to the following rates:

- Return travel to and from Prague: 275 euros.
- Return travel to and from Warsaw: 275 euros.
- Accommodation allowance per night: 79 euros.

Students of the University of Milan who successfully complete the course will be awarded 6 credits for workshop learning activities.

### **Who can apply**

Applicants must be regularly enrolled in the second or third year (a.y. 2024/25) of the Bachelor *Studies in Cultural Heritage* at the University of Milan for the 2024/2025 academic year and until the end of the educational activity (June 2025).

In order to receive the 4EU+ travel and accommodation allowance, they cannot be a recipient of any other EU grant for stays abroad that overlap, even partially, with the physical mobility period.

### **Study Content**

The programme lasts one academic year (from November 2024 to June 2025) and is structured as follows:

- 6 Conversatory Classes [online]
- 15 Tutorial lessons [online]



- 3 two-days workshops (Milan, January 16-17, 2025; Prague, March 20-21, 2025; Warsaw, June 5-6, 2025)

### Selection process

Up to 8 students from the University of Milan can be selected for the 2024/2025 edition of the Programme.

Candidates will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Letter of motivation: up to 10 points.

The selection will be carried out by Prof. Davide Colombo, Giorgio Zanchetti.
