STUDY AWARD #FINDTHEORANGE - A. Y. 2024/2025

THE RECTOR

- Having regard to the Study Award Regulations, issued by Rector's decree no. 4728/21 on 10 February 2021;
- Having regard to the proposal submitted on 5 September 2024 by the non-profit organisation #FindTheOrange for the establishment of a study award aimed at promoting the study and advancement of knowledge regarding technical and scientific resources for health protection, to be granted during the a. y. 2024/2025;
- Having regard to the resolution passed by the Academic Senate on 22 October 2024, which approved the establishment of said study award for the a. y. 2024/2025;

HEREBY DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

The University of Milan is accepting applications for a study award amounting to €2,500.00 (two thousand five hundred euros), to be granted to a student enrolled on track, during a. y. 2024/2025, in the second year of the Master's degree programme in <u>Human Centered Artificial Intelligence</u>. To be eligible for said award, students must have earned at least 90% of their first-year university credits (CFU/ECTS) by 30 September 2024, with a weighted grade average not lower than 28/30. Additionally, their University ISEE 2024 (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator, which for 2024 is calculated on the income and assets held in 2022) must not exceed €35,000.00.

Applications must be submitted between 9 am on 25 November 2024 and 12 am on 24 January 2025 by completing the following form:

The online form will not be accessible after 12 am on 24 January 2025. Applicants may not change or add anything to their submission once the application deadline has expired.

When completing the application form, applicants are required to upload the following documents in PDF format:

- Self-certification form attesting to their enrolment in the second year of the Master's degree in Human Centered Artificial Intelligence during the a. y. 2024/2025, including the list of all exams passed and the respective grades, plus their weighted grade average (the form can be downloaded online from the former SIFA online services);
- University ISEE certificate 2024 (the ISEE value is calculated on the income and assets held in 2022).



The Rector shall appoint a Selection Board and grant the study award to the applicant proposed by said Board.

Pursuant to article 3, paragraph 3, of the Study Award Regulations, the award is indivisible. The award is subject to withholding taxes as required by Italian law and will be disbursed to the winner in a single payment.

The outcome of the competition will be communicated to all applicants at the email address which they entered into their application form. For further information, please write a message via $\frac{1}{2}$ Fees and Benefits $\frac{1}{2}$ Scholarships.

Should the winner renounce the study award on grounds of its incompatibility with another benefit already granted to him/her, or due to his/her withdrawal from studies during the a. y. 2024/2025, he/she shall return the entire sum of the award to the University.

In this case, the study award will be granted to the next-ranked applicant.

Pursuant to article 8, paragraph 2, of the Study Award Regulations, a study award may not be granted by the University to anyone who has already won a previous award on the basis of the same qualifications.
