



THE ERASMUS+ PROGRAMME

- WHAT? Study abroad experience, recognised in your UNIMI career-Recognition of exams and credits;
- WHY? Cultural and linguistic enrichment. Competitive CV and advantage in the job market;
- WHERE? In a European country, at one of UNIMI's partner universities;
- WHEN/HOW LONG? Academic year 25/26. Depending on the duration defined by the bilateral agreement, one semester or a whole academic year. 12 months, between study and traineeship, for each study cycle (24 months for single-cycle courses). Min 2, max 12 months per academic year. All the mobilities must end by the 31st of July 2026.
- WHO? Students regularly enrolled in the a.y. 25/26, who are not offtrack by more than one year at the time of application for the current cycle of study.
- FINANCIAL SUPPORT? Erasmus+ scholarship based on the destination country and possible additional contribution based on your income.
- HOW? Online application, from 4 to 28 February 2025, at 1 pm. Don't wait until the last day!

Courses:

- Disciplinary Area in Biotechnology Bio-Industrial curriculum (Bachelor's degree programme)
- BioTechnologyand Bioinformatics (Master's degree)
- Bioinformatics for Computational Genomics (Master's degree)
- Quantitative Biology (Master's degree)

Specific requirements:

Students enrolled:

- at least in the **second year** of Bachelor's degree programme in Biotechnology (K06), who have chosen the Molecular-bioinformatics curriculum
- Students enrolled in the abovementioned Master's degrees

Students enrolled at the Bachelor's degree in Biotechnology should apply only to the destinations that refers to their curriculum.

Minimum A2 level in the working language used at the host university required.

- How can I know which is the working language? You have to visit the websites of the universities of your interest and check their academic offer.
- All the students need to submit a certification recognized by the University/SLAM statement/ screenshot of their career where the level obtained is clearly stated.
- Exceptions: Students from the Areas of Language Mediation, Veterinary Sciences and Foreign Languages, students who study in English (→ Form 2: Self-certification of language skills + oral interview).



Application

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Application

We invite our students to read the Call for applications and the Guidelines carefully.

The following must be uploaded during the application:

- a valid identity document
- CV and previous academic records in a single file
- proposed Learning Agreement (form 1)
- documentation regarding language proficiency in a single PDF file (language certificate or SLAM certificate, screenshot of your career with the language level obtained, or self-certification using form 2, in accordance with the requirements of the degree programme at home (Read carefully paragraph 4 of the Call for applications)
- any other relevant document to support your application (optional).

At the end of the procedure students can download a PDF with a summary of their application.

It is possible to take part in a mobility programme more than once, for study or Traineeship - up to a maximum of 12 months overall for Bachelor's and Master's programmes and 24 months overall for single-cycle degree programmes.

1. APPLICATION EVALUATION


You will be evaluated by a designated Commision on three components (Language, Learning Agreement, CV and career) according to the **criteria and scores indicated in Annex A**

To be **eligible**, you must obtain <u>at least 1 point in</u> <u>each component</u>. You must undertake the **oral interview**, or you will be banned from the selections (only when required by the Call).

Min. 3 points - Max. 15 points

Erasmus Index

Number calculated with reference to the year of enrollment, the **GPA** and the **credits obtained so far**



Only the exams taken and registered on your career before 03/03/2025 will be considered. PARTIAL/MID-TERM EXAMS cannot be counted!

The Erasmus Index will be calculated on a **15**-**point basis**.

INTERVIEWS (when required)

<u>The interviews will take place</u> <u>between March 7 and March</u> <u>14, 2025.</u>



REPLACEMENTS

- Vacant Eligible students who were not selected for any destination will be put on the waitlist for each destination they were eligible for.
- After the first window for acceptance is closed, the online platform will generate a new ranking, reassigning any vacant places to eligible students on the waitlist. Students, summoned by ranking order, may choose whether to accept or waive a vacant destination within the second acceptance window. The students will be informed of the dates of this second acceptance window.
- Students on the waitlist can be called until July 16, 2025.
- Selected students who withdraw from the assigned destination will not be considered for their second or third choices.
- If a student on the waitlist is offered a destination on their application and they do not accept it, they will not be reconsidered for other destinations.
